Recently, several water resource recovery facilities in the Upstate of South Carolina have been affected by illegal dumping of PCBs (polychlorinated biphenyls). PCBs are chemicals that were used as coolants and lubricants in transformers, capacitors and other technical equipment and were banned from production by Congress in 1979.
